

Did you know that there are three Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs)

located in the Terminal and Concourse?



They are located near the Information Desk, in Baggage Claim near the escalators and at the end of the connector near the entrance to the Food Court. They are enclosed in red carrying cases and are kept in alarmed white boxes with a red strobe on the top. They are for use by all Airport employees and tenants, and opening the box will activate a piercing alarm tone and the red strobe light. You do not need to be certified in CPR to use the AEDs; the device will walk you through all the steps to apply the pads and even perform CPR in accordance with the latest American Heart Association and American Red Cross guidelines. Since irreversible brain damage occurs in only 4-6 minutes after the heart stops, time is critical when a person suffers a heart attack. According to the National Institutes of Health, sudden cardiac arrest occurs on an average of 325,000 a year in the US alone; about once every two minutes. You **can** be the difference between life and death!
